7. **Application No. PD-060-26, Marquis Crossing:** Consider proposed Ordinance No. 26-17 requesting to amend the York County Zoning Map by reclassifying an approximately 22-acre portion of a 32-acre parcel located at 200 Water Country Parkway (Route 640) from Economic Opportunity to Planned Development Mixed Use, subject to voluntarily proffered conditions. **Approved as amended**
8. **No Wake Administrative Committee Recommendation.** Consider adoption of proposed Resolution R26-126 to create a Board policy on the criteria for "no wake" zones and their designating markers. **Approved**
9. **No Wake Administrative Committee Recommendation.** Consider adoption of proposed Ordinance No. 26-18, an Ordinance to amend the County's Code to update the original language to match the language of the Board policy and current usage. **Approved**
